I. FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT

A. Other ways to express the thought in Ephesians

- The church is the fullness of Him who fills all in all
 Eph. 1:23
- 2. Filled up to all the fullness of God Eph. 3:19
- 3. Measure of the stature which belongs to the fullness of Christ Eph. 4:13
- 4. Filled with the Spirit Eph. 5:18

B. Fullness of the Spirit is the expression of God in a believer

III. SUBMISSION AND SERVICE

A. Paul could have used the word for service but chooses submission

- 1. Service could be taken as acts of service
- 2. Paul's thought involves the loss of control of my life

B. Example of the Lord

- 1. All things are under His control
- 2. Because He loved us He served us
 - a. Served us in coming to earth

- b. Served us in His death on the cross
- c. Serves us today as head of the church
- d. His role in serving limited His personal potential

IV. MUTUAL SUBMISSION WORKED OUT IN COMMON

RELATIONSHIPS

A. Marriage

- 1. Wives submit
 - a. Required by Roman law
 - b. Now an act of service to the Lord
- 2. Husbands love
 - a. Act of humiliation in the Roman world
 - b. Love limits opportunity love by giving yourself for her

B. Family

- 1. Children obey your parents
 - a. Required by law
 - b. Now an act of service to the Lord
- 2. Fathers bring up your children for the Lord
 - a. Serve the children for the Lord's sake

C. Slave Master

- 1. Slaves obey your masters
 - a. Required by law
 - b. Now as a proof of your love for the Lord
- 2. Masters be concerned for your slaves
 - a. Treat them as people with equal standing before God
