### I. KEY VERSES ON PRAYER FROM PAUL

- A. Colossians 4:2 **Devote** yourselves to prayer, **keeping alert** in it with an attitude of thanksgiving;
- B. Ephesians 6:18 With **all** prayer and petition pray at **all** times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be on the alert with **all** perseverance and petition for **all** the saints,
- C. 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 *Rejoice always;* pray *without ceasing; in everything* give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

### II. PAUL'S OUTLOOK

- A. Paul counted on the presence of God with him.
- B. Paul recognized that God was always working out a predetermined plan.
  - 1. Plan was always being worked out.
  - 2. Plan was being worked out in and through Paul.
- C. Paul realized that his prayers had an impact on that plan being fulfilled.

## III. OUTWORKING OF THESE REALITIES IN PAUL'S LIFE

- A. Evidence must come from Paul's letters.
- B. Summation of the types of evidence we have from those letters:
  - 1. Testimony of his own prayer life
  - 2. Records of the content of his prayers
  - 3. Thanksgiving he expresses as he writes
  - 4. Benedictions he pronounces on those to whom he writes
  - 5. Outbursts of praise
