  - 1. All believed in God

  - 3. All had been instructed innacurately on what that truth meant.
- B. Jesus accurately reveals what that Word said.
  - 1. All who heard had two alternative patterns of thought.
- C. Jesus demands a response. (Matt. 7:24)
  - 1. If you hear these words
  - 2. And act on them

## III. TEMPTATION OF EVE

### A. Her situation

- 1. No doubt about the existence of God
- 2. No doubt about the goodness of God
- 3. Fully aware of the directive of God
- B. The Serpent An alternative take on the situation
  - 1. Does not argue about the existence of God
  - 2. Appeals to her God-given desire to reach the highest good
  - 3. Challenges the truthfulness of the Word of God
  - 4. Argues that the greatest potential for her life will come by making full use of the created realm
- C. Eve's dilemma two alternative paths to fulfillment
  - 1. Paths
    - a) Life is found in a right relationship with God.
    - b) Life is found in the full use of the created realm.
  - 2. Eve must act.
    - a) She will believe one or the other.
    - b) She will take action on what she believes.
