I. FAITH PLEASURES GOD. *WITHOUT FAITH IT IS IMPOSSIBLE TO PLEASE HIM.*


A. Faith does not earn the favor of God.

B. Faith receives from God.

II. FAITH SEEKS GOD. *FOR HE WHO COMES TO GOD MUST BELIEVE.*

A. Faith always moves towards the living God.

B. God's saving purpose is that we should know Him.



III. FAITH LISTENS TO GOD. *FOR HE WHO COMES TO GOD MUST BELIEVE THAT HE IS.*

- A. Not just that He exists

- B. That He is the God He revealed Himself to be
 - 1. In the Old Testament

 - 2. In the person of Jesus Christ

- C. Example of Moses
 - 1. God made a promise to Abraham.

 - 2. God made a covenant with Abraham.

 - 3. Moses responded by renouncing Egypt.

IV. FAITH FINDS GOD. *AND HE REWARDS THOSE WHO SEEK HIM.*

- A. Reward is not instantaneous.

- B. Reward is the knowledge of God Himself.
