Romans 5:1-11

- A. Declared righteous by the Judge.
  - 1. In the work of Christ in His death sin is taken away.
  - 2. In the work of Christ in His life righteousness is granted.
- B. Justification secures a standing with God.
  - 1. The standing is perfect and eternal.
  - 2. In practice in our present life we are not perfect.

## II. JUSTIFICATION AND RECONCILIATION

- A. Purpose of the Judge in justifying is that we can know God as our Father.
- B. The broken relationship with God is over.
- C. The love of God is now permanently on us.

## III. JUSTIFICATION IS THE FOUNDATION FOR SANCTIFICATION

- A. We have a right standing but are still in need of purification.
- B. We are also given a new life.
- C. The new life does not secure immediate holiness in practice.
- D. Justification enables us to exult (rejoice) while God does His purifying work.
