- A. Love God with all your heart.
- B. Love your neighbor as yourself.

- A. A new desire to please and glorify God
- B. Real opposition to carrying out this desire

III. PATH OF SANCTIFICATION - ROMANS 6-8

- A. The work of God in Christ Romans 6:1-14
 - 1. Believer is placed in Christ. Romans 6:3
 - 2. The believer's old self was crucified with Him. Romans 6:6
 - 3. In His resurrection, the believer was made alive to God. Romans 6:10

B. Response of faith

- 1. Count yourselves dead to sin and alive to God. Romans 6:11
- 2. Present yourselves to God. Romans 6:13
 - a. As a servant of God
 - b. Only option is to be the slave of sin Romans 6:16
- 3. Do not go back to the Law. Romans 7:1-6
 - a. Law could not justify.
 - b. Law cannot sanctify.
- 4. Walk in the Spirit. Romans 7:6, 8:14
 - a. Let Him teach you the Word.
 - b. Let Him renew your mind.
 - c. Let Him strengthen you in the inward man.
